The BAPF is a yearly summer festival of the country's most compelling, competitive, and diverse new plays in development.

The Literary Associate will support the Literary Manager and Artistic Director in all appropriate and necessary functions related to the literary programs of the Playwrights Foundation. They will assist the Literary Manager on a variety of tasks, including but not limited to: script solicitation and evaluation, managing the submissions catalog, coordinating script reading assignments, tracking and cataloging script reports, communicating with playwrights, scheduling festival selection meetings, and general administrative tasks.

Most work can be done remotely, but regular meetings with the Literary Manager, and participation in other scheduled meetings may be necessary.
